As required under section 8 of the *Electoral Boundaries and Representation Act* ("the Act") and further to my letter of July 15, 2022, I wish to provide you with updated information concerning the number of electors in each electoral district current to October 12, 2022.

In addition, through our GIS technical support to the Commission, I have provided a digital file containing the updated number of electors for each polling division, or part of a polling division, within each electoral district.

In total, there are 571,662 electors listed in the register of electors distributed among the 49 electoral districts of the Province. The electoral quotient is therefore 11,667 electors per electoral district.

I look forward to assisting you in your work as required.

Dear Messrs. Theriault & Clinch,

As required under section 8 of the *Electoral Boundaries and Representation Act* ("the Act"), with the establishment of the Commission on July 15, 2022, I wish to provide you with information concerning the number of electors in each electoral district. A summary by electoral district is included as Appendix A. Appendix A also shows the difference in the number of electors in each electoral district in comparison to the allowed deviation of 15% from the electoral quotient (see subsection 11(5) of the Act).

In addition, I have provided a digital file containing the number of electors for each polling division, or part of a polling division, within each electoral district.

In total, there are 573,993 electors listed in the register of electors distributed among the 49 electoral districts of the Province. The electoral quotient is therefore 11,714 electors per electoral district.

To facilitate your work, we have made advance preparations to assist with geography work. We have mapping software that will enable you to group various polling divisions together to build new proposed districts dynamically and give running totals of eligible electors in each electoral district. As well, with this software, we have the ability to break out the number of electors to individual points on the ground, should it be required to split a polling division. Finally, we will be able to plot paper maps or provide electronic images of any proposed designs for your public consultations.

I look forward to assisting you in your work as required.
