- 1. In accordance with section 6(6) of the Regulation, it has been determined that the undertaking may proceed following approval under all other applicable acts and regulations.
- Commencement of this undertaking must occur within three years of the date of this Determination. Should commencement not be possible within this time period, the undertaking must be registered under the *Environmental Impact Assessment Regulation (87-83) – Clean* <u>Environment Act</u> again, unless otherwise stated by the Minister of the Environment and Local Government.
- 3. The proponent shall adhere to all obligations, commitments, monitoring and mitigation measures presented in the *Proposed Fredericton Airport Annex Building EIA Registration* report (dated July 14, 2005), as well as to those from all subsequent correspondence and reports during the registration review.
- 4. If it is suspected that remains of archaeological significance are discovered during construction, all activity shall be stopped near the find and the Resources Manager of the Archaeological Services Unit, Heritage Branch of the Culture and Sport Secretariat, shall be contacted at (506) 453-2756.
