## **MINISTER'S DETERMINATION**

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

Pursuant to Regulation 87-83 under the Clean Environment Act December 7, 2009 File Number: 4561-3-1227

- 1. In accordance with section 6(6) of the Regulation, it has been determined that the undertaking may proceed following approval under all other applicable acts and regulations.
- 2. Commencement of this undertaking must occur within three years of the date of this Determination. Should commencement not be possible within this time period, the undertaking must be registered under the *Environmental Impact Assessment Regulation* (87-83) Clean Environment Act again, unless otherwise stated by the Minister of Environment.
- 3. The proponent shall adhere to all obligations, commitments, monitoring and mitigation measures presented in the EIA registration documentation dated August 12, 2009 and to those in all correspondence during the registration review. Additionally, the proponent shall submit a summary table detailing the status of each Condition listed in this Determination to the Manager of the Project Assessment Section every 6 months from the date of this Determination until such a time when all the Conditions have been met.
- 4. The proponent must obtain an *Approval to Construct* for the project prior to the commencement of any construction activities. For additional information, please contact Mr. Don Grass, Project Assessment and Approvals Branch, at (506) 444-4599.
- 5. Implementation of the project must not result in any new emission sources or increases in emissions.
- 6. Pile driving required as site preparation is limited to 7:00 to 18:00, Monday to Friday and may not be carried out on Sundays or statutory holidays.
- 7. The proponent shall ensure that all developers, contractors and operators associated with the construction and operation of the project comply with the above requirements.
