MINISTER'S DETERMINATION CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL Pursuant to Regulation 87-83 under the <u>Clean Environment Act</u> August 8, 2011 File Number: 4561-3-1296

- 1. In accordance with section 6(6) of the Regulation, it has been determined that the undertaking may proceed following approval under all other applicable acts and regulations.
- Commencement of this undertaking must occur within three years of the date of this Determination. Should commencement not be possible within this time period the undertaking must be registered under the *Environmental Impact Assessment Regulation* (87-83) – <u>Clean Environment Act</u> again, unless otherwise stated by the Minister of Environment.
- 3. The proponent shall adhere to all obligations, commitments, monitoring and mitigation measures presented in the EIA registration document dated March 9, 2011 as well as all those identified in subsequent correspondence during the registration review. Additionally, the proponent shall submit a summary table detailing the status of each Condition listed in this Determination to the Manager of the Environmental Assessment Section of the Department of Environment every 6 months from the date of this Determination until such a time as all the Conditions have been met.
- 4. Prior to commencing construction of this Project, the proponent must obtain an *Approval to Construct and Operate* from the Impact Management Branch, Department of Environment. - 5.
