MINISTER'S DETERMINATION

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

Pursuant to Regulation 87-83 under the *Clean Environment Act*October 4, 2021

File Number: 4561-3-1565

- 1. In accordance with section 6(6) of the Regulation, it has been determined that the undertaking may proceed following approval under all other applicable acts and regulations.
- 2. Commencement of this undertaking must occur within three years of the date of this Determination. Should commencement not be possible within this time period the undertaking must be registered under the *Environmental Impact Assessment Regulation* (87-83) *Clean Environment Act* again, unless otherwise stated by the Minister of Environment and Climate Change.
- 3. The proponent shall adhere to all obligations, commitments, monitoring and mitigation measures presented in the document entitled, "Environmental Impact Assessment, Registration Document, North West Sanitation Services Ltd. Importation of Daily Cover Material Grand Falls, New Brunswick, dated June 3, 2021", as well as all those identified in subsequent correspondence during the registration review. Additionally, the proponent shall submit a summary table detailing the status of each condition listed in this Determination to the Director of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Branch of the Department of Environment and Local Government (DELG) every six months from the date of this Determination until such a time that all the Conditions have been met.
- 4. The proponent is permitted to import daily cover material from Quebec to be placed in a pile at the existing construction and demolition debris disposal site (PID 65225682).
- 5. The proponent shall ensure that the imported daily cover material meets the criteria of construction and demolition debris as described in the *Approval to Operate S-3406*.
- 6. The use of the imported daily cover material shall be described in the *Facility's Site Operations Plan Approval to Operate S-3406.* For more information, please contact the Authorizations Branch, DELG, at (506) 453-7945.
- 7. In the event of the sale, lease, or any other conveyance or change of control of the property, or any portion thereof, the proponent must provide written acknowledgement from the lessee, controller, or purchaser confirming that they will comply with the Conditions of this Determination to the Director of DELG's EIA Branch.
- 8. The proponent shall ensure that any proposed project modifications or future expansions are submitted for review and approval to the Director of the EIA Branch, DELG, prior to implementing the changes.
- 9. The proponent shall ensure that all developers, contractors and operators associated with the development project comply with the above requirements.
