Dear Sir:

We have received a copy of the draft Environmental Impact Assessment Registration document for Nicholson's Waste Management Ltd., prepared by Natech Environmental Services Inc. for the proposed Nicholson's Septage De-watering Facility.

Robinson's septic received the following approval from the Planning Review and Adjustment Committee of the Regional Service Commission 11 on March 25, 2014:

"...that the Planning Review and Adjustment Committee of the Regional Service Commission 11 allow the use of a Waste Management Business on PID #75234989 as being similar to or compatible with uses permitted in the "Rural" zone under the *Nashwaak Valley Planning Area Rural Plan Regulation – Community Planning Act* subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a) any applicable Department of Environment and Local Government regulations be adhered to;
- b) that outdoor lighting be located, arranged or shielded as not to interfere with traffic proceeding along Killarney Road or with nearby landowners in the reasonable enjoyment of their properties; and
- c) that all signs be in accordance with applicable provisions of section 3.13 of the *Nashwaak Valley Planning Area Rural Plan Regulation*, and in accordance with any applicable Department of Transportation and Infrastructure policies".

After discussions with the proponent it is our opinion that the decision made by the Planning Review and Adjustment Committee is still valid as the facility's main focus or land use is a Waste Management Facility.

The Planning Division of RSC 11 will take part in the public consultation process through the Environmental Impact Assessment and will also provide stakeholder input at that time.
