Re: **Public Involvement in Environmental Impact Assessment**

Dear property owner:

Nicholson's Waste Management has been operating septage holding facility on a wooded property off the Killarney Road, civic #590 Route 148. Rather than trucking septage to a de-watering facility in Fredericton, it is planned that a de-watering facility be installed on the Killarney Road property. Effluent from the operation will be treated in constructed engineered wetlands, before being polished with a sand filter.

This development is undergoing a routine provincial Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) registration, as outlined in Section 5 (1) and Schedule "A" of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulation. As part of the EIA registration, the developer is required to inform local interest groups and neighbours within 1km of the planned development. The consultation and the EIA registration are being handled by NATECH Environmental Services Inc.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to improve the efficiency of the de-watering process and to protect the environment from effluent discharges. The proposed project involves: a) removing the existing storage tanks, and b) replacing them with one large concrete storage tank, installing an 'In the Round' de-watering system, construction of an engineered wetland, and a sand filter to treat the effluent water. The treated effluent will be infiltrated into the ground on the property. Pending approval from the NB Department of Environment and Local Government (NBDELG), construction is planned to start in the spring of 2018.
