

Property Tax Certificates Online Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. What is a Property Account Number?

A Property Account Number (PAN) is assigned to your property to identify it for assessment and taxation purposes. A Property Tax Certificate can not be ordered by using a Parcel Identification Number (PID).

2. How do I obtain a Property Account Number?

The Property Account Number is located in the upper right portion of the Assessment and Tax Notice. If the Property Account Number is unknown, you should contact Service New Brunswick Assessment Services for assistance in the area where the property is located. 3. What are my payment options for online orders?

For online orders we accept VISA and MasterCard. All transactions are in Canadian dollars.

4. Is it safe to use my credit card?

The Department of Finance uses Moneris Solutions as its credit card service provider. For more information about Moneris Solutions please visit <http://www.moneris.com>.

5. Will I receive a receipt for my order?

You will be able to print a receipt online upon successful completion of your order, and you will also receive a receipt by e-mail. You should print and keep the receipt for your records.

6. How do I track my order?

An Order Reference Number is assigned to your order and noted on your receipt. This number should be quoted when making inquiries on the order.

7. Why do I have to provide an e-mail address?

An e-mail address is required for online delivery of the Property Tax Certificate(s) and receipt.

8. Will my personal information be safe?

Collected personal information will only be used by authorized government employees to fulfill the purpose for which it was originally collected or for a use consistent with that purpose. 9. How much is the fee to order a Property Tax Certificate online?

The fee to order a Property Tax Certificate online is twenty dollars (\$20.00 CAD) per account.

10. How will the order appear on my credit card statement?

Your credit card statement will appear as follows: NB Tax Certificates \$20.00.

11. Will the system be available twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week?

Property Tax Certificates can be ordered twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

12. Why is Adobe Reader required?

An Adobe Reader is required to view and print a Property Tax Certificate and receipt in PDF format, and can be downloaded free of charge at <http://www.adobe.com>.
