

Safely Operating Courts During a Pandemic

How the Courts are Keeping you Safe



With the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic we understand it can be stressful to attend public places. We want you to feel safe. New Brunswick courts have taken steps to ensure it is safe for you to attend court when required.

What you can expect from us:

- Regular cleaning of frequently touched surfaces
- Limiting visitors to required court participants only
- Limits on the number of people in courtrooms
- Additional points for hand sanitizing
- Continued use of video and teleconferencing where possible
- Clearly marked signage and barriers to ensure physical distancing
- Screening upon entrance to a courthouse



What we ask of you:

- Stay home and call 811 if you are experiencing symptoms related to COVID-19. Advise of your absence by contacting your lawyer or the court in your jurisdiction
- Wash your hands with soap and water when you can, sanitize your hands regularly when you are unable to do so
- Maintain appropriate physical distancing when speaking to someone
- Follow instructions posted on signs and listen to the direction provided by sheriff's officers. This is to keep you safe
- Bring a community face mask
