

GOODWIN LAKE

DESCRIPTION

Location: Miramichi drainageStretch type: Daily Crown Reserve

• Size: 20.2 hectares

Average depth: 2.9 metres
Maximum depth: 7.6 metres
Shoreline: 1814 metres

• Fish present: Brook Trout, American eel

ACCESS

NOTE: Access to certain stretches may require four-wheel drive vehicles.

- 1. From the City of Miramichi, travel 28.5 km Northwest on Route 430 to Wayerton Bridge.
- 2. From Wayerton Bridge, travel 3.5 km to the mouth of the Fraser Burchill Road (this is a gravel road on the left).
- 3. On the Fraser Burchill Road, travel 19 km to a junction of the Fraser Burchill Road. Bear right.
- 4. Travel a further 21.9 km to another junction of the Fraser Burchill Road. Bear right.
- 5. Then travel 5.4 km to the mouth of the Spruce Lake Road. Bear right onto the Spruce Lake Road.
- Travel 3.9 km to the mouth of the Goodwin Lake Road (turn right).
- 7. Travel 2.3 km to an intersection (bear right).
- Travel 2.0 km to the camping area and the lake access road (turn left).
- 9. This road is about 140 metres long and leads to a parking area.
- 10. From the parking area there is a trail to the lake that is about 150 metres long.

ACCOMMODATIONS

- Camping area only
- Fire pit provided
- Picnic table and outdoor toilet facilities
- Anglers must provide their own drinking water.
- Firewood is not provided. It is recommended that only kiln dried firewood be brought to Crown Reserve to
 minimize the risk of spreading invasive insects and disease. If using firewood that has not been kiln dried,
 buy it locally (as close to your destination as possible), burn it all on site and do not bring any remaining
 firewood home.
- Garbage removal is the angler's responsibility. Littering is strictly prohibited.
