

ISLAND LAKE

DESCRIPTION

- Location: Miramichi drainage
- Stretch type: Daily Crown Reserve
- Size: 19 hectares
- Average depth: 1.0 metres
- Maximum depth: 1.5 metres
- Shoreline: 2,132 metres
- Fish present: Brook Trout and Blacknose Dace

ACCESS

NOTE: Access to certain stretches may require four-wheel drive vehicles.

1. From the village of Doaktown, travel 6.6 km North on the Hazelton Road and turn left onto the Hazelton Crossover Road (this is a gravel road).
2. Travel 11.6 km to a junction in the road. Bear right onto the Russell & Swim Road.
3. On the Russell & Swim Road, travel 10.1 km north and turn left onto the Valentine Lake Road.
4. On the Valentine Lake Road, travel 3.4 km to reach Island Lake on your right.
5. The camping area access road is on the right, 400 m before reaching the lake.

ACCOMMODATIONS

- Camping area only
- Fire pit provided
- Picnic table and outdoor toilet facilities
- **Anglers must provide their own drinking water.**
- Firewood is not provided. It is recommended that only kiln dried firewood be brought to Crown Reserve to minimize the risk of spreading invasive insects and disease. If using firewood that has not been kiln dried, buy it locally (as close to your destination as possible), burn it all on site and do not bring any remaining firewood home.
- Garbage removal is the angler's responsibility. Littering is strictly prohibited.

REGULATIONS
