

# **KENNY LAKE**

# **DESCRIPTION**

Location: Miramichi drainageStretch type: Daily Crown Reserve

Size: 19.8 hectares

Average depth: 1.5 metres
Maximum depth: 2.4 metres
Shoreline: 2,374 metres
Fish present: Brook Trout

# **ACCESS**

**NOTE:** Access to certain stretches may require four-wheel drive vehicles.

- 1. From the city of Miramichi, travel 28.5 km Northwest on Route 430 to Wayerton Bridge.
- 2. From Wayerton Bridge, travel 3.5 km to the Fraser Burchill Road (gravel left side).
- 3. On the Fraser Burchill Road, travel 19 km to a junction of the Fraser Burchill Road. Bear right.
- 4. On the right-hand branch of the Fraser Burchill Road, travel 15 km to a junction of the Fraser Burchill Road. Bear right onto the Kenny Lake Road.
- 5. On the Kenny Lake Road, travel 0.5 km to a junction. Bear left.
- Travel another 4 km (turn right).
- 7. Travel 0.3 km and bear left.
- 8. Then travel 3.3 km to a junction in the road (bear right).
- 9. Travel 1.1 km to the lake access road on your right.
- 10. Travel 300 metres on this road to Kenny Lake.

# **ACCOMMODATIONS**

- Camping area only
- Fire pit provided
- Picnic table and outdoor toilet facilities
- Anglers must provide their own drinking water.
- Firewood is not provided. It is recommended that only kiln dried firewood be brought to Crown Reserve to
  minimize the risk of spreading invasive insects and disease. If using firewood that has not been kiln dried,
  buy it locally (as close to your destination as possible), burn it all on site and do not bring any remaining
  firewood home.
- Garbage removal is the angler's responsibility. Littering is strictly prohibited.
