


Crown Reserve angler advisory – Upsalquitch Forks Pool Stretch

Recent changes to the Southeast Upsalquitch River have seen its juncture with the Northwest Upsalquitch River shift to a location approximately 200 metres downstream from the Upsalquitch Forks Pool Crown Reserve camp.

This natural alteration of the riverbed channel has resulted in canoeing hazards such as active stream bank erosion and woody debris and trees in the watercourse. Crown Reserve anglers are advised to use extreme caution when navigating this stretch of river by canoe.
