

# BIG BALD MOUNTAIN



## Why is this area under consideration?

Located in the Appalachian Range, Big Bald Mountain enhances one of New Brunswick's smallest Protected Natural Area, which is nested within this 2,100 ha site.

## QUICK FACTS

- Hosts many rare plant species such as Northern Blueberry, Northern Firmoss and Glandular and Dwarf White Birches.
- Includes 140 ha of old Black Spruce forest and 640 ha of mature Jack Pine forest that has naturally regenerated following forest fires.
- Provides habitat for the at-risk Olive-sided Flycatcher.
- Peaks and waterfalls within the area provide opportunities for low-impact outdoor recreation.
