## Why is this area under consideration?

Shepody Mountain is one of the Amazing Places within the Fundy Biosphere Reserve. The 510 ha area would complement existing protected areas such as Hopewell Rocks Provincial Park and Caledonia Gorge Protected Natural Area.

## QUICK FACTS

- The mountain and 360 ha of Red Spruce and Balsam Fir forests provide an inspiring journey and panoramic view to the willing explorer.
- Would protect habitat for the at-risk aquatic lichen Eastern Waterfan.
- Includes Shepody Bay West Important Bird Area (IBA), an important stopover site for many shorebird species in eastern North America.
