### Written Examinations


- A minimum grade of 70% must be achieved to successfully pass a written examination in a designated occupation.
- Marks will be recognized for a maximum of six years.

Note. The mark required to successfully pass the written examination in the Blaster Occupation is 75%.

### Practical Assessments

- Blaster Occupation
  - The mark required to successfully pass the practical assessment is 75%
  - The mark on the practical assessment remains valid for 2 years
- Mobile Crane Operator Occupation
  - The mark required to successfully pass the hand signals practical assessment is 100%
  - The mark required to successfully pass the load chart practical assessment is 70%
  - The mark required to successfully pass the equipment operation practical assessment is 70%
  - The mark on the practical assessment remains valid for 2 years

In some instances, the Apprenticeship and Occupational Certification Board may require a practical assessment to be successfully completed prior to the issuance of a Certification of Qualification Without Written Exam.
