1. Purpose:

To interpret and define the procedures of processing vehicles requiring transit markers.

2. Procedure:

- A. Unregistered Commercial Vehicles coming into or traveling through the Province of New Brunswick are to be processed as follows:
 - i. Unladen single vehicles and unladen combinations must display a Dealer Plate or Transit Marker/Temporary Permit from any jurisdiction on each unit
 - ii. Piggy Back Operations must display either a New Brunswick "Transporter Plate" attached to the drive vehicle or a New Brunswick "Special Trip Permit", with up to two towed vehicles only, or a dealer or transporter plate from any jurisdiction.

3. General:

- A. Unregistered Commercial Vehicle:
 - i. HSE Officers/Sergeants must adhere to the following guidelines when issuing New Brunswick Transit Markers, with special attention to Quebec vehicles.
- B. Transit Markers (Form 3013) that are now being issued by the officers are not to be confused with Special Trip Permits (Form 3014) which are issued under the terms of the IRP
- C. Transit Markers are to be issued under the following criteria:
 - i. for a maximum of three (3) days
 - ii. the vehicle (s) is properly insured (driver must furnish proof of insurance)
 - iii. the vehicle(s) is unladen
 - iv. the vehicle(s) is not registered in any jurisdiction
 - v. Vehicle may be single unit or tractor-trailer combination.

D. Exception:

Note: Section 21(1) Every motor vehicle, trailer, semi-trailer, pole trailer and all special mobile equipment operated on a highway, shall be registered under this part except (b.1) any such vehicle being towed by a tow truck in accordance with this Act and regulations.
