PURPOSE

To establish procedure guidelines in reference to portable communication equipment.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

NB Corrections Act.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all employees of the Adult Custody Services division of the Department of Justice and Public Safety.

POLICY GUIDELINES

Portable communication equipment is critical to the safe and effective operation of an Adult Custody facility. Staff will receive orientation on radio protocol, terminology, and local procedures upon commencement of employment. Approved radio and telephone procedure will always be followed

PROCEDURE

Local policy

Procedures will be developed at each institution for.

- Storage.
- Maintenance.
- Assignment.
- Codes used; and
- Delegation of responsibility for radio/cell phone equipment.

Radio use

Staff assigned radios/cell phones will.

- Speak plainly, clearly, distinctly and at a speed which will be understood
- Keep transmissions short and to the point



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- Do not discuss personal information staff or clients on the radio
- Do not shout.
- Use <u>no</u> profane language or derogatory terms
- Hold mic 1" to 2" from your mouth
- Spell words which may be confused with similar sounding words
- Test your radio/cell phone at the commencement of every shift
- Use a cell phone for business calls only
