CAPABILITY OVERVIEW

As part of its responsibilities, Department of Transportation and Infrastructure (DTI)'s Radio Communications Division maintains sites and equipment in very remote locations – particularly in the northern areas of N.B., but also where weather and seasonal challenges inhibit site access by normal means.

This ATV, with tracks, along with its enclosed trailer allow the team to better serve its clients in the remote areas and perform:

- Maintenance to site infrastructure
- Enhanced response capabilities during extended event outages
- Transporting of equipment and fuel to remote sites
- Site evaluations and routine visits during all seasons
- Remote radio coverage solutions
- Assistance to other agencies as required

We have a number of communication tower locations which are very remote in N.B. This allows us year-round access in all weather conditions to help maintain this critical infrastructure network and ensure client networks are available when they need to be.
